A. Joking Relations (D1-3)

A very short procedural text from Durga identifying those who are in a *hasi* (joking) relationship. One's *hasi* relations are acceptable marriage partners.¹

A.1 Free Translation of Text

Researcher: *What about hasi log?*

About *hasi log* (joking kin). Mother's brothers sons and daughters are to be called *hasi* (joking kin). They are *moena* brothers and *moena* sisters. They are to be called *hasi* (joking kin).
