

Male Step Relationships in Hindi

The Hindi word for a male step relationship is "Sautelā" (सौतेला).

Here are some examples:

Sautelā pitā (सौतेला पिता) - Stepfather

Sautelā betā (सौतेला बेटा) - Stepson

Sautelā bhaī (सौतेला भाई) - Stepbrother

Sautelā dādā (सौतेला दादा) - Step-grandfather

Sautelā nānā (सौतेला नाना) - Step-maternal grandfather

The word "sautelā" is derived from the Sanskrit word "sautrika" which means "of another woman" or "born of a different wife."

It is used as a prefix before the relevant kinship term to indicate a step relationship on the father's side. For example:

Sautelā pitā = Stepfather (father from another wife)

Sautelā betā = Stepson (son from another wife)

On the other hand, for step relationships on the mother's side, the word "saut" (सौत) is used. For example:

Saut bhaī (सौत भाई) - Stepbrother (from another husband)

Saut mā (सौत माँ) - Stepmother

Some examples:

Mere sautelē pitā bahut ummīd se dekhte hain. (मेरे सौतेले पिता बहुत उम्मीद से देखते हैं।) Translation: My stepfather looks at me with great expectations.

Usne apne sautelē bhaī kī bahut madad kī. (उसने अपने सौतेले भाई की बहुत मदद की।) Translation: He helped his stepbrother a lot.

Mere saut mā se merā khaṭṭā-mīṭhā rishta hai. (मेरी सौत माँ से मेरा खट्टा-मीठा रिश्ता है।) Translation: I have a bittersweet relationship with my stepmother.

So, in essence, "sautelā" is the Hindi word used to denote a step relationship from the father's side for males in the family.
